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

During the transition from the current generation of CM/ECF to the next generation of CM/ECF, or NextGen, PACER users who are appointed as CJA attorneys will have two different methods for changing their exempt status, depending on which generation of CM/ECF the court is running.

Activate Your CJA Privileges - Current CJA Attorneys

1. Contact the PACER Service Center (PSC) at (800) 676-6856 or email them at pacer@psc.uscourts.gov to request that CJA privileges be added to your upgraded PACER account. You must provide:
 - A. Your name, username, and the account number of your upgraded PACER account. You can find this information by logging in to Manage My Account in PACER.
 - B. The district in which you have been appointed to the CJA attorney panel.
 - C. Your PACER-exempt account information, which includes your username and account number. You can find this information by logging in to Manage My Account in PACER. (NOTE: Once CJA privileges are activated for your upgraded PACER account, your PACER-exempt account will be canceled.)
2. The PSC will send you an [Click here.](#) instructions on how to proceed.

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Use these steps to activate your CJA privileges for current CJA attorneys. Your CJA privileges must be activated in order to receive your fee exemption when using your upgraded PACER account to view reports and documents.

There are several steps in this process. First, you must contact the PACER Service Center by phone or email and give them your name, the username, and account number of your upgraded PACER account; the district in which you have been appointed as a CJA attorney; and the username and account number of your current exempt PACER account.

Please note that once CJA privileges are activated on your upgraded PACER account, your current PACER-exempt account will be canceled as you will now be able to view reports and documents in both CurrentGen and NextGen courts, and switch between exempt and non-exempt status using your upgraded PACER account. Click Continue.

Activate Your CJA Privileges - Newly Appointed CJA Attorneys

1. Contact the PACER Service Center (PSC) at (800) 676-6856 to request that CJA privileges be added to your upgraded PACER account. You must provide:
 - A. Your name, username, and the account number of your upgraded PACER account. You can find this information by logging in to Manage My Account in PACER.
 - B. The district or circuit court in which you have been appointed to the CJA attorney panel.
2. The PSC will send you an email with the CJA acknowledgment and instructions for exempt usage.
3. Reply to the email with your acknowledgment. Your CJA privileges will not be activated until the PSC receives your email reply.

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Use these steps to activate your CJA privileges for newly appointed CJA attorneys. Your CJA privileges must be activated in order to receive your fee exemption when using your upgraded PACER account to view reports and documents.

There are several steps in this process. First, you must contact the PACER Service Center by phone or email and give them your name, the username, and account number of your upgraded PACER account; and the district in which you have been appointed as a CJA attorney.

The PACER Service Center will send an acknowledgment email with instructions on how to use your exempt account. You must then reply to the email with your acknowledgment. Your CJA privileges will not be activated until the PACER Service Center receives your email reply.

- In CurrentGen CM/ECF, use your upgraded PACER account to view case information for private work.
- Add an X- prefix to your upgraded PACER username when performing exempt work.
- You must log out, and then log back in to switch between exempt and non-exempt status, removing the X- prefix for non-exempt work.

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For courts running the current generation of CM/ECF, you will log in using your upgraded PACER account to view case information for private work.


However for exempt work, rather than having a separate PACER-exempt account as it is done today, you must add an X- prefix to your upgraded PACER username, once CJA privileges are added to your account by the PACER Service Center. A helpful hint to remember this is to think X- for exempt. If it's exempt, it gets the X- prefix. If it is not exempt, it does not get the X- prefix.

To switch back to non-exempt status, you must log out of the system, and then log back in again, removing the X- prefix from your PACER username. Note that the only thing that changes when switching between exempt and non-exempt status is your username.

Your password stays the same. Click Continue.

Change PACER Exemption Status Utility for NextGen Courts

- In NextGen CM/ECF, you will be able to switch between exempt and non-exempt status without having to log out.
- Use the Change PACER Exemption Status utility.
- Use your exempt status when performing exempt work and non-exempt status when performing non-exempt work.

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In NextGen CM/ECF, you will be able to log in and switch between exempt and non-exempt status using the Change PACER Exemption Status utility, which is a new feature of NextGen CM/ECF. This utility allows you to turn on exempt status when performing exempt work, and to change the exemption status back to non-exempt when performing non-exempt work. Click Continue.
